When we engrave a HELLA TEK with personal medical/emergency information, we will "activate" the TEK by enameling the cross on the side. Activated TEKs alert First Responders to critical information available on the back.









10mm TEKs hold 3 lines of engraving. Each line can be up to 24 characters including spaces.
5mm TEKs hold one line of text, with 24 characters including spaces.
